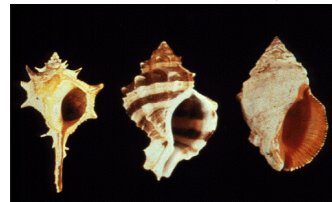

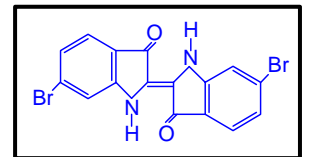

Estimated Itinerary:

<u>Time</u>	<u>Description</u>
30 min	Arrive, Self-Tour of Museum
20 min	Watch Video
10 min	Collect Snorkeling Gear
50 min	Snorkel
10 min	Return to Museum
30 min	Learn Dye Procedure
15 min	Conclude

Directions are as follows:

Taking the "2"

From the coast hwy (2) get off at the Zichron Yaakov exit and follow the road **east**. The first light is the old coast hwy (4), turn **left** to go north.

Taking the "6"

From Kvish Shesh (6) get off at the Zichron Yaakov exit and follow the highway (70) **west** till the old coast hwy (4), turn **right** to go north.

ALL continue as follows

Follow the 4 past Fureidis (village on your right) and then look for the sign that says "Dor/Nachsholim"; make a left and follow this road all the way till you come to a parking lot. Just before the parking area there is a gate on the right with the words "Malon Nachsholim"; pull up to the gate, press the buzzer and tell them you are going to the museum. Once inside the gate, park where ever you can (there is additional parking immediately to the right when you come through the gate - and this brings you even closer to the "beit mizgaga" where we meet). Follow the pathways to the museum/"beit mizgaga" which is an old two-story building to your right.

Misc. Details:

- All participants should arrive in bathing suits, T-Shirts, water shoes.
- It is advisable to bring a towel, sun-screen, (goggles), water & food.
- Women are requested to wear t-shirts for snorkeling.
- There is no partial payment for partial participation.
- There is a 20% fee for cancellations less than one week in advance.
- All cancellations must be made and confirmed by phone.
- Payment is in cash or check only.
