You can set WAZE to "HaMizgaga Museum - Nahsholim" or drive as follows:

Taking the "2"

From the coast Hwy (2) get off at the Zichron Yaakov exit and follow the road East. At the first light – the old coast Hwy (4) – turn Left to go North.

Taking the "6"

From Kvish Shesh (6) get off at the Zichron Yaakov exit and follow the highway (70) West till the old coast Hwy (4), turn Right to go North.

ALL continue as follows:

Follow the road (4) past Fureidis (village on your right) and then look for the sign that says "**Dor/Nachsholim**".

Make a Left and follow this road all the way till you come to a parking lot. Just before the parking area there is a gate on the right with the words "Malon Nachsholim"; pull up to the gate, press the buzzer and tell them you are going to the museum.

Once inside the gate, park wherever you can (there is additional parking immediately to the right when you come through the gate - and this brings you even closer to the "**Beit Mizgaga**" where we meet). Follow the pathways to the museum/Beit mizgaga which is the old brick building to your right.
